CALL TO ORDER:

Commission Chair Crawford called the Wednesday, November 5, 2025, Commission Meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

COMMISSION BUSINESS:

FIR- HRC # 2025003H: Lagunas v. Parc Reston Association: It was moved by Commissioner Salinas and seconded by Commissioner Hudson that the complaint be dismissed due to insufficient evidence that a violation of the Fairfax County Fair Housing Act has occurred consistent with the recommendation of OHREP. The motion passed by unanimous vote.

Appeal- HRC #2019018E/ EEOC# 10D- 2019-00041- – Diba v. Perspecta Inc.: It was moved by Commissioner Salinas and seconded by Commissioner Hudson, that the staff finding be upheld and this matter be dismissed due to no cause finding. The motion passed with majority vote with Commissioner Malik opposing.

COMMUNITY CONCERNS: Director Mike Simms informed the commission of a meeting with advisors from Mount Vernon's Supervisor's Office to discuss community outreach and efforts to improve communication on what each supervisory district is doing. Director Simms informed the Commissioners that he would get a list of upcoming events to share with the Commission.
