PRESENTATIONS

ITEMS

County Executive Ed Long announced he will be retiring in September, ending his 40 year career with the Fairfax County.

The Board voted to adopt the **FY2018 Budget Plan**.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

Admin 1: The Board authorized the Department of Family Services to apply for and accept grant funding for a pilot program to develop a cohort of family child care providers who will provide high quality PreK and comprehensive services to at-risk four-year-olds.

Admin 5: The Board approved advertising for a public hearing on proposed zoning ordinance amendment that would increase the minimum expenditure per dwelling unit for recreational facilities required in Planned Development Districts (PDH, PDC, PRM, and PTC Districts). The hearing will be held on June 20, 2017.

ACTION ITEMS

Action 1: The Board authorized the Director of Fairfax County Department of Transportation to support the establishment of access for a pedestrian facility and permitting a break in the limited access line on southeast quadrant of Route 7 and the Dulles Toll Road.

Action 3: The Board approved policies regarding major service changes, disparate impact, and disproportionate burden to meet Federal Transit Administration (FTA) requirements. The policies demonstrate

how the County is complying with Title VI requirements, including prohibiting discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, or economic status.

Action 4: The Board endorsed the recommended list of potential improvements for consideration for the Transform I-66 Outside the Beltway project.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

There were no public hearings on cases in the Hunter Mill District at this meeting.
