

Seven Corners Area Demographics – Snapshot

1. **Seven Corners has seen slower population growth than the County.** The Population is approximately 5,800 (2012). Growth rate has been around 1% since 2000, and is expected to be similar over the next five years. Fairfax County population growth is expected to be around 3%.
2. **Seven Corners is extremely diverse.** White residents make up 41% of the population, with all other races comprising the remainder (2012). Asian-identified residents made up 19% of the population, and 8% were identified as black or African American. The area's Hispanic or Latino population is 53%. By comparison, the County was approximately 63% white in 2011, with 16% of residents identified as Hispanic or Latino.
3. **Seven Corners residents rely on a variety of transportation modes.** In 2012, approximately 44% of workers drive to work alone, 23% carpooled, 23% used public transportation, and 10% used other means, including walking or biking. By comparison, County-wide, 73% of residents drive to work alone, 9% carpooled, 10% used public transportation, and 3% used other means (2011). Nationally, around 75% of people drive to work.
4. **Seven Corners income levels tend to be lower than those County-wide.** The estimated median household income in Seven Corners for 2012 was \$43,834. This compares to a median household income of \$105,797 for the County in 2011. Only about 14% of Seven Corners households make at or above the County's median household income.
5. **Seven Corners tends to have lower levels of education attainment than the County as a whole.** Approximately 42% of Seven Corners residents have received a Bachelor's Degree or higher (2012). This compares to the County as a whole, where 59% of residents had received a Bachelor's Degree or higher (2011). At the same time, 28% of Seven Corners residents had not obtained a high school diploma or equivalent (2012). In comparison, only 7% of residents County-wide had not graduated from high school or received a GED.
