The Mount Vernon Memorial Highway Trail Project completes missing segments for several trails. The project constructed a 6,400 foot long, 10- foot wide shared use path which includes a pedestrian bridge adjacent to the Mount Vernon Memorial Highway bridge crossing Dogue Creek.

- East Coast Greenway Trail
- Potomac Heritage National Scenic Trail
- NoVA Loop Trail





There will be a short inaugural bike ride/walk after the event so bring your bike or walking shoes if you'd like to join in!
