    - vii. Legal liability in addition to minimizing risk of negligence, user groups should be aware of the difficulty of any claimant proving they contracted the virus due to negligent user group activity. This is a very difficult standard for a potential claimant to meet (proof by a preponderance of evidence that they contracted the virus at a user group event and not elsewhere)
    - viii. Contact tracing and reporting what are user groups supposed to do?
