## **Scholarship Program Overview**

- \$150,000 annual budget
- Funds are disbursed over winter, spring, and summer/fall seasons
- The amount available for each season is dependent upon the number of total seasonal applicants the previous identical season

# Applicants may request the following two forms of assistance:

- 1. Registration Fee Waiver
- 2. Equipment Voucher
  - \*\$150 per athlete/\$300 per fiscal year



# **Scholarship Program Overview**

#### Eligibility

- To be eligible for a scholarship, athletes must qualify for or be currently receiving assistance such as Free/Reduced School Lunch or Medicaid
- Athletes must meet each of the criteria:
  - Be a resident of Fairfax County;
  - Enrolled in school (K-12th grade);
  - Commit to attend a minimum of 80% of scheduled practices and games; and
  - Not be currently served by an existing scholarship or fee waiver program.

To Apply

#### 1. Complete the Youth Sports Scholarship Application

- available on the website in English and Spanish
- 2. Submit to the club
- 3. Club will verify the applicant and supporting documentation
- 4. Club submits Scholarship League Verification Form and applicants to NCS by the season deadline
- 5. Deadlines:
  - Winter February 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Spring May 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Summer/Fall November 1<sup>st</sup>



# How does NCS calculate the amount available per applicant, per season?

Step one, NCS assigns a percentage/portion of the annual budget (\$150,000), based on the number of participants in the previous year, Fall, Winter, Spring/Summer.


• Example: If 9.14 % of the overall applicants were in the winter season last year, winter will receive 9.14% of the available funding this year. 9.14 % of \$150,000 is approximately \$13,710

Step two, the **current** number of applications divided by the dollar figure assigned to each season (step one) determines the reimbursement amount per player:



• Example: \$13,710 / 499 players (winter season) = \$27.47 per player

## 5 -Year Total Scholarship Applicants 2015-2020



32,055 Total Applicants

\*Dollar amount reflects the reimbursement per athlete over the entire fiscal year

#### Funding Comparison from 2015 - 2020 Scholarship Fund Reimbursed \$32.76 per applicant over 5-year period
