The Advertised Budget Plan is the annual budget proposed by the County Executive to the Board of Supervisors for the upcoming fiscal year, which runs from July 1

through June 30. This Plan is based on estimates of projected expenditures for County programs, and it provides the means for paying for these expenditures through estimated revenues. The County's budget serves as the documentation of the financial, policy and service decisions for the fiscal year and contains some of the best sources of information on County governmental programs and services and financial information for policy makers and managers.

In addition to the [80+ clinics and health care providers](#) offering testing, community testing is available in neighborhoods where socioeconomic factors and transportation make it difficult to access testing. The [Health Department's testing sites](#) are open Monday through Friday in locations based on epidemiology (disease) data and input from community leaders. No appointment is necessary and testing is free of charge.
