

## **Grant Overview**

## What is a trauma-informed space?




Promotes safety and a sense of calm. Gives opportunities for





Uses design elements like calming colors, connection to nature, warm lighting, and clear signage

Invites community voice and choice and promotes selfsufficiency



Promotes social connectedness while offering space for privacv



## Why fund trauma-informed spaces?

- High rate of trauma in the population
- Collective trauma since 2020
- You never know who will walk through your doors
- Your space precedes you!
- Physical space can be a tool for successful
  - interaction/participation

## History of Trauma-Informed Spaces Grant

- 2019-2022: Trauma-Informed Spaces mini-grant program funded through the Fairfax County Partners in Prevention Fund and Family and Children's Trust Fund (FACT)
- Dozens of community organizations funded through this program
- 2022: Additional funding secured through the American Rescue Plan Act










## **Purpose of the grant**

Respond to community needs and interest

- To fund both county government and community partner spaces
- Provide technical assistance and support to organizations and locations working to establish trauma-informed spaces




## **FY23 Trauma Informed Spaces Grant**



- \$150,000 available for community partners
- The funding limit for requests is \$5,000 per request
- Funding can be used to improve the physical environment
- Applications accepted October-December
- Notification of awards in January 2023
- Projects to be completed by May 2023
- Reimbursements sent after receipt of project completion

## **Community Partners Funding**

- The TICN is seeking applications from organizations who provide front-line human services to populations who may have experienced trauma
  - FCPS and NCS CRCC sites will submit applications to internal agency leadership for approval.
- Eligible applicants: community-based organizations, nonprofits, local government agencies, faith-based organizations, private schools, childcare centers, and small businesses



- Requests for smaller amounts will be considered
- Grant funds cannot be used to provide services or for staff costs, training, or curriculum materials



## **Dos and Don'ts of Funding**

#### Can fund:

- Painting/painters
- Construction/construction workers
- Furniture
- Artwork
- Plants
- Lighting
- Signage
- Sensory toys

#### Cannot fund:

- Programs
- Services
- Staff costs
- Curriculum
- Training



## **Grantee Responsibilities**



- Adhere to all stipulations outlined in the grant agreement
- Provide a W9 for the organization
- Register for a Unique Entity ID through SAM.gov
- Keep track of all purchases through receipts, packing slips, invoices, etc.
- Notify the project manager of any significant changes
- Submit before and after photos of the space

- Application released & proposals accepted

#### <u>November</u>

• Virtual Open House, 11/15 at 2:00PM

#### December

Application deadline

#### <u>January</u>

- Notification of awards
- Signed grant agreements

#### February-May

Project completion

#### <u>June</u>

- Final reporting
- Reimbursements



## **Application Components**



Applicants will be required to apply for each site where they plan to complete a project



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- Attach an itemized budget worksheet with items for purchase
- Complete a SAM.gov registration for a UEI if the organization does not already have one





## **Selection Process and Notification**



- Applications will be reviewed by TICN staff
  - Selections will be made in early 2023
  - To be contacted via email
  - Will need to sign grant agreements at the time of notification



## **Completing Projects**



- Make purchases using your organization's funds
- Don't forget before photos
- Get creative with after photos/videos
- Let us know if you want to share your space with the community at a TICN meeting!
- Plan to send all receipts, invoices, packing slips, etc. in May 2023

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

Wisdom from previous cycles



What happens if an item that I requested in my budget worksheet becomes unavailable?

- Grantees are permitted to make minor changes to their funding requests as needed
- We recognize that the ongoing pandemic and related supply chain problems may mean that modifications need to be made
  - If it's something small like getting a different model of the same item that you requested, you can do so without notifying the project manager



#### How do I keep track of receipts, packing slips, etc.

- Please keep both electronic and physical copies of all receipts, packing slips, invoices, etc. from the items that you purchase as part of your application
- Hold all your records in a secure location until the submission window
- Submit electronic versions of your documentation to the project manager by the deadline
  - Please do not send each record to the project manager individually during the purchasing process



#### Can I hire staff to provide service using these funds?

 No, these funds are only available for infrastructure improvements and for contractors who will provide a service to accomplish that goal



#### What happens if I don't track/submit receipts?

You will not receive payment via reimbursement for any items that do not have a corresponding receipt.



My organization doesn't have the funds to purchase items up front. Can you give us funding in advance instead of reimbursing us?

> No, funding will be provided after the receipt of completed projects. No advance funding is available.

Do I have to complete my project by the deadline or just have purchased everything by the deadline?

> Deadlines are purchasing deadlines. It's okay if project work extends beyond the deadline.
