## We can help if:

- You are in a relationship in which you are being physically and/or emotionally abused.
- You have been sexually assaulted and don't know what to do.
- You are being stalked or harassed.
- You are a family member or friend of a survivor of sexual assault, domestic violence, stalking or human trafficking and you want to know how to help them.
- Your children have witnessed domestic violence.
- You were sexually assaulted some time ago and are now having difficulty because of this past trauma.
- You have been abusive toward a partner or family member and you want to stop your abusive behavior.
- You have separated from an abusive partner and need help making the transition.
- You want to leave an abusive relationship and have nowhere to go.
- You would like help understanding/navigating the legal system and support in applying for a protective order.

- **Hotline** (Domestic violence, sexual violence, stalking, or human trafficking)

24-hour telephone counseling, information and referrals. Interpreters are available for hotline calls in any language. Call 703-360-7273, TTY 711.

- **Advocacy Services: DVAC**

For victims of domestic violence, sexual violence and stalking. Includes crisis intervention, safety planning, options counseling, assistance with protective orders, court accompaniment and specialized housing and economic education. Call the Domestic Violence Action Center (DVAC) at 703-246-4573, TTY 711.

- **ADAPT: Anger & Domestic Abuse Prevention and Treatment**

A certified 18-week batterer intervention program in which participants are taught to prevent abuse through the development of compassion for themselves and others. Call 703-968-4052, TTY 703-324-5706.

- **Community Education, Outreach and Prevention**

Presentations available for community groups, organizations, schools and any other interested parties. Call 703-324-5730, TTY 703-324-5706.

- **Compassion Training for Couples in Conflict**

For couples who wish to work on healthier ways to relate to one another. Call 703-207-6979, TTY 703-324-5706.

- **Consultation and Training**

Available for professionals who work with clients whose lives are affected by domestic and/or sexual violence, stalking or human trafficking. Call 703-324-5730, TTY 703-324-5706.

- **Counseling: Individual and Group**

Individual counseling for survivors of domestic violence, sexual violence, stalking or human trafficking, as well as individual and family counseling for children who have experienced sexual abuse or witnessed domestic violence. Group counseling available for survivors of domestic or sexual violence.

- **Men's Survivors' Group**

A support group for men who were sexually abused as children. Call 703-704-6727, TTY 703-324-5706.

- **Hospital Accompaniment**

When requested, for victims of sexual assault or domestic violence. Call our 24-hour Domestic and Sexual Violence Hotline at 703-360-7273, TTY 703-435-1235.

- **Referrals**

Links clients to additional services including social services, legal referrals, job counseling, housing information and many others. Call 703-324-5730, TTY 703-324-5706.

- **Emergency Shelter: Artemis House**
