Proclamation

WHEREAS, Fairfax County's children are among its most valuable and vulnerable residents and require consistent care and attention; and

WHEREAS, some children are born with developmental delays and disabilities and it is essential that they receive timely and appropriate early intervention services; and

WHEREAS, the Infant & Toddler Connection of Fairfax-Falls Church provides critical early intervention services to more than 4,000 infants and toddlers with developmental delays and disabilities across Fairfax County each year; and

WHEREAS, strong partnerships among county agencies, physicians, private care providers and families of children with disabilities support early intervention services that foster development and promote long-term well-being; and

WHEREAS, it is important that Fairfax County residents are aware of the early intervention services available for infants and toddlers with developmental delays and disabilities so families can access resources and opportunities that improve their children's outcomes; **NOW THEREFORE**

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors, on behalf of all residents of Fairfax County, hereby recognizes May 2026 as

Early Intervention Month

in Fairfax County and urges all residents to recognize the importance of early intervention services for infants and toddlers with developmental delays and disabilities and for their families throughout the community.
