Medicaid Update



Post-partum coverage for pregnant women has been extended from 60 days to 12 months!

Some exceptions apply. Unqualified immigrant pregnant women enrolled in the FAMIS prenatal category continue to be entitled to post partum coverage for 60 days only.

Unqualified immigrants include but are not limited to undocumented individuals, those with work/visitor/student visas, legal permanent residents without five years, etc.



The public health emergency was extended to October 13,2022. Reduction or termination of Medicaid coverage continues to be prohibited.



SNAP Benefits Update



EBT Benefit Expungement Rule Change

Previously, unused SNAP benefits were expunged after 12 months (365 days) of inactivity.

There was a mandatory change in federal regulation. Unused SNAP benefits will now be expunged after 9 months (274 days) of inactivity...

The state is also required to provide notice to individual households prior to expunging benefits 30 days prior to the date the benefits will be expunged.




