

Location

- 9518 Richmond Highway
- ~ 6.2 acres (0.7 acres adjacent site)





Lorton Community Center

- 2-Story Building with Gym
- 33,000 Total Square Footage
 - ~29,500 SF for Community Center including Senior Center
 - ~3,500 SF for Lorton Community Action Center



Lorton Community Action Center



- Lease with Fairfax County
- Murphy House: 2,053 SF
- Trailer: 1,904 SF (2010 Special Exception)



Lorton Senior Center

- 9397 Richmond Highway (Currently located in Gunston Plaza)
- Current Program 4,000 SF
- New Program 8,000 SF
- Current lease expires June 30, 2018 with option to extend 3 years





Lorton Community Library

- 9520 Richmond Highway
- Constructed in 1990 9,923 SF
- Serves a population of 34,193 & FY 2016 circulation of 120,865
- Currently proposed for the 2026 Bond Referendum
- Renovation to upgrade building and infrastructure and meet current and future operational needs of the Library System



Lorton Park

- Classified as a community park daily recreation
- Short durations of recreation in active or passive uses
