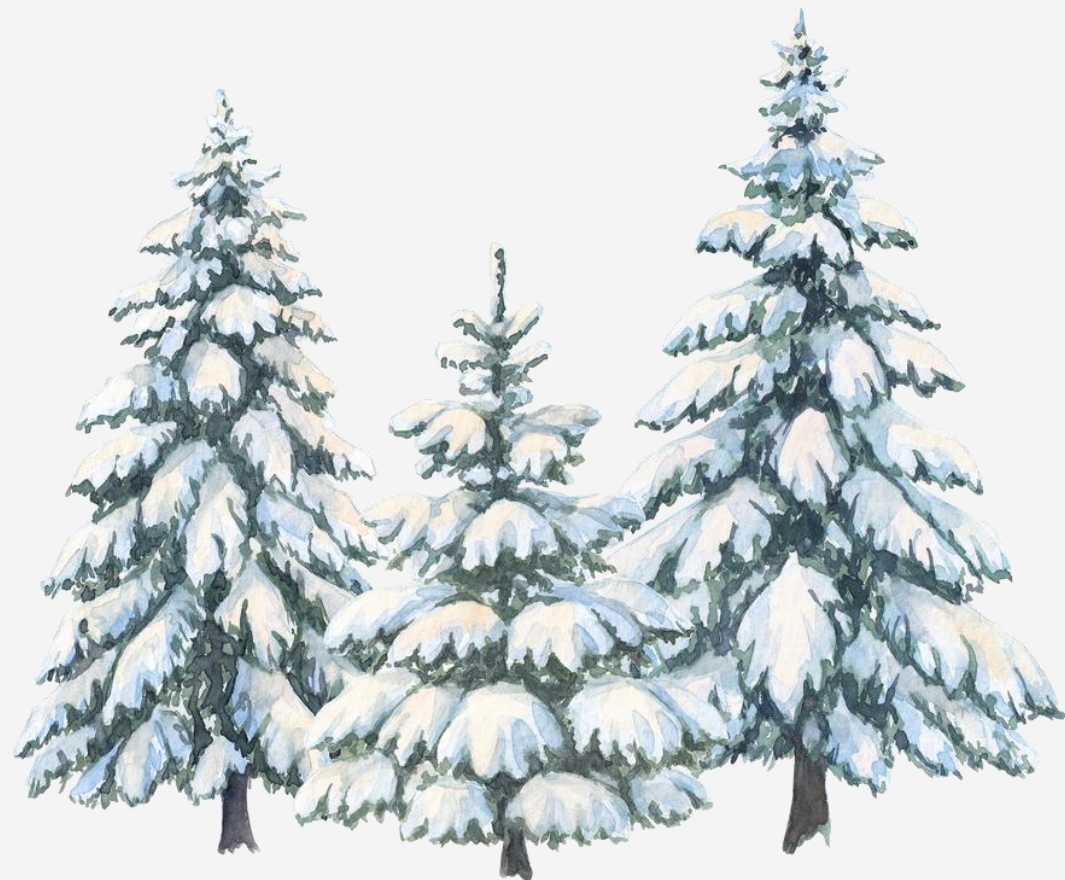
Winter 2025 - 2026 Statistics Snapshot

Registration Totals over the Past Year

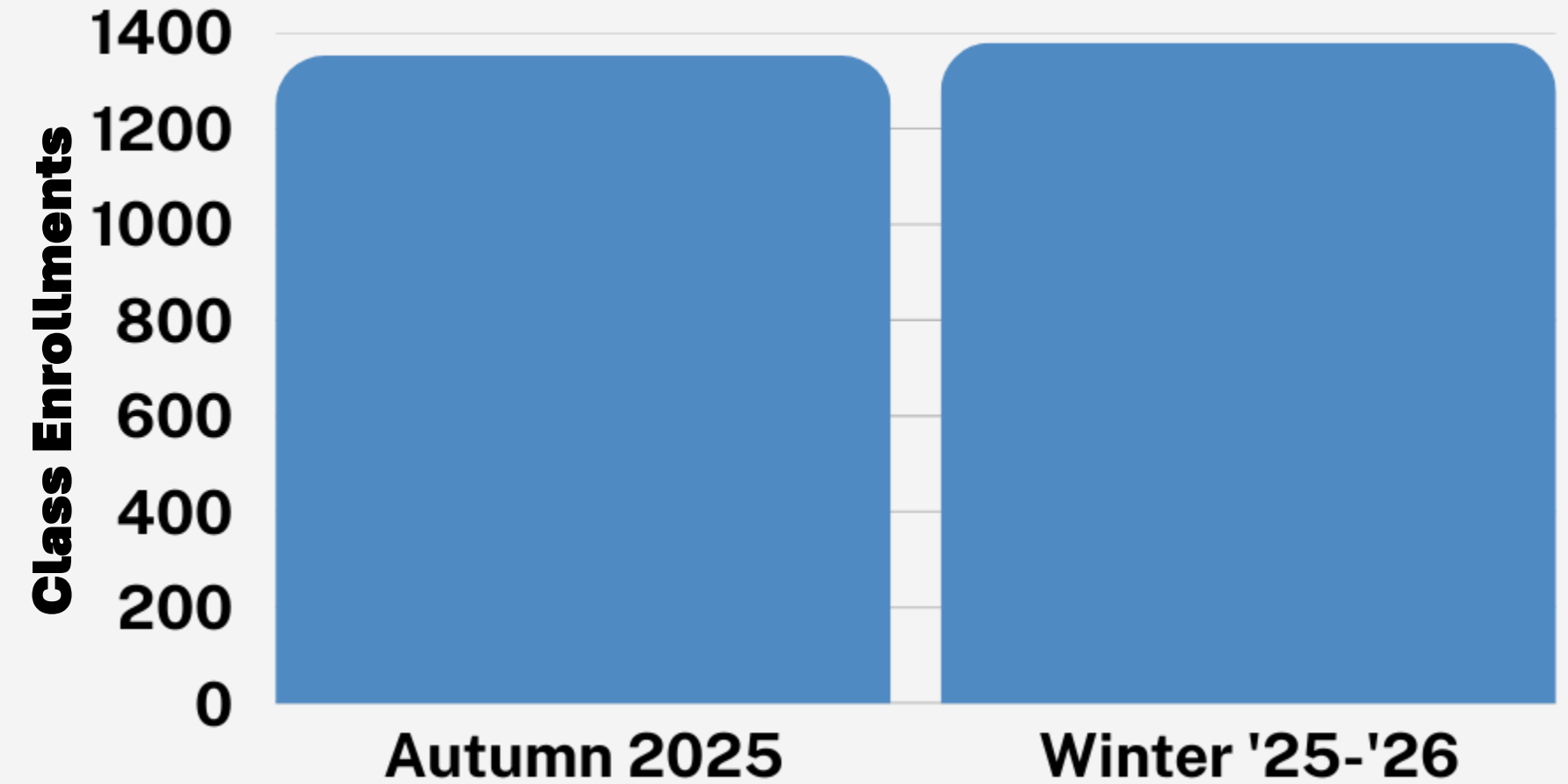
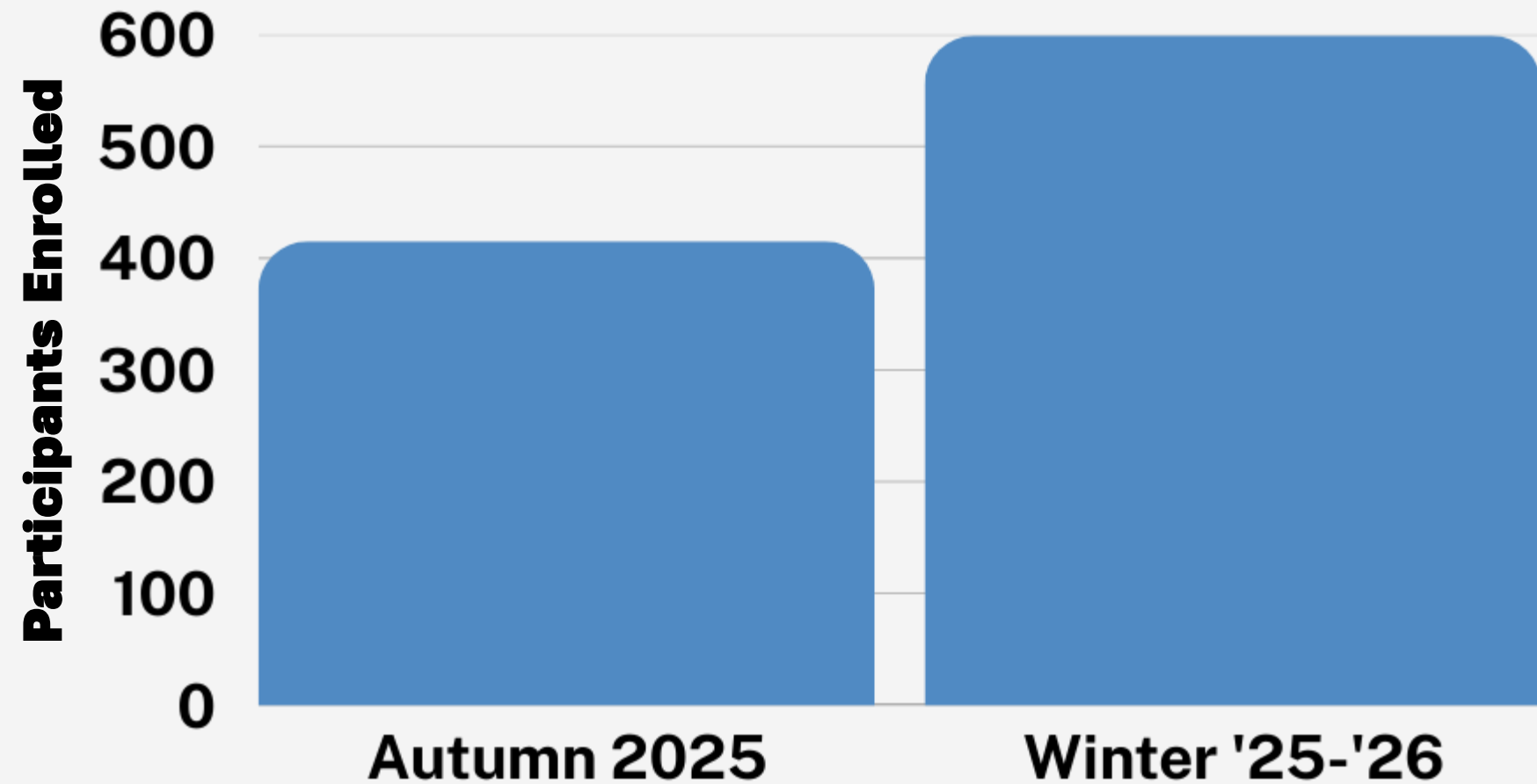
This chart represents the total amount of participants who registered for each session. Compared to Autumn 2025, the program saw an increase in **184** registrations by participants.
