Code of Conduct

I understand that center users in any capacity who do not respect the Code of Conduct may be asked to partake in a restorative justice process. This process is based on center policies and participant/member needs, regardless of income, age, gender, ethnicity, or race, and physical or mental ability, behavior, or lifestyle. Every attempt will be made to allow other center users involved to be equal partners in this process.

General Liability Waiver

In consideration of the services to be rendered in connection with NCS programs, I, for myself and the child(ren) or adult for whom I am parent, legal guardian, or caretaker fully assume all of the risks associated with the participation of myself, my child(ren), or adult in the NCS programs, including any and all risks of injury or illness. As such, I hereby agree to waive, release, defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Fairfax County, and its current and former employees, servants, agents, directors, Board members, departments, agencies, assigns and insurers, or all of them, from any and all liability, damages, and actions brought by myself, by or on behalf of my child(ren), and/or by or on behalf of the adult for whom I am a caretaker, in connection with their participation in NCS programs.

Health and Safety Guidance

Fairfax County's priority continues to be a safe environment for all. While participating in any of the Burke/Springfield Senior Center Without Walls classes, everyone is strongly encouraged to abide by safety practices put in place, including observing social distancing, when possible; practicing proper hand washing; and **refraining from coming to class if you are feeling ill**. Masks and face coverings are optional for participants, and we support mask use for individuals who choose to continue to wear them. Registration information provided to the Fairfax County Neighborhood and Community Services is public record and as such may be released under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act (VFOIA) unless the participant specifically requests that this information not be released. Registration Guidelines

For your safety: Lining up prior to 10 a.m. is strictly prohibited. Failure to comply with this policy may result in a delay in your registration. All participants will be emailed a number. This number will correspond to a time to come in to register for three initial classes. If you did not receive a number for registration, please visit the front desk to receive your number. Registration is required for all instructor-led classes. Individuals who fail to register in a timely manner will not be permitted to participate in classes. Only Fairfax County publications, websites, and correspondence are to be used for registration and scheduling. Registrations are not accepted past the second week of classes. All registration is done **in-person** at the Burke-Springfield Center for Active Adults.

Registration Dates:

Registration begins Monday, February 9, 2026 at 10:00am. Rolling Registration will be **February 17 – March 13, 2026**. During Rolling Registration, you may register for additional classes past the initial 3.

RECDynamics Accounts

A current RECDynamics account is **required** to successfully register for classes. A free account can be made at <https://fairfax.usdirect.com/ncsweb/>. **Registrations will not be accepted unless you are registered in RecDynamics.** You will have the ability to create an account at the in-person registrations, however we encourage you to create an account in advance.

Class Fees and Payment

Classes that have a fee of either \$5 (residents) or \$10 (non-residents) is for the entire session. No refunds or exchanges will be made. Exact change is requested. Cash, check, and money orders are the only acceptable forms of payment. No credit card payment will be accepted. No bills larger than \$20 please. If paying by check or money order, make payable to "NCS" for the total amount of all registered classes. Registration is not considered complete until correct payment is received.
