Beginning this week, every household in Fairfax County, the cities of Fairfax and Falls Church and the towns of Herndon and Vienna will be receiving a COVID-19 toolkit in the mail. Please look for it in your mailbox and encourage your program's staff and families to look for it as well. It is important that everyone open, read and retain this document as a household reference during the COVID-19 pandemic. This document outlines the self-isolation, self-care and prevention measures that an individual with COVID-19-like illness should undertake, including instructions of what to do if you are sick with symptoms of COVID-19, what to do if you are in close contact with someone who is sick, and how to identify and talk to close contacts who are at risk for illness.
