

Are you a CLASS[®] Observer *or* interested in becoming one?

Ready Region Capital Area is seeking observers for the Classroom Assessment Scoring System, better known as CLASS.

CLASS is a nationally-recognized observation tool for evaluating the quality of educator-child interactions in a developmentally appropriate way across birth-five programs.

- *Infant CLASS = birth-18 months*
- *Toddler CLASS = 15-36 months*
- *Preschool CLASS = 3-5 years*

Each CLASS tool measures multiple aspects of age-and developmentally appropriate teacher-child interactions that support children's learning and development.

Research shows that the quality of teacher-child interactions has a direct and positive impact on child outcomes and the quality of early learning programs.

1. Email NCSReadyRegionCapitalArea@fairfaxcounty.gov to register to attend the Fall 2022 training sessions. Costs are covered by the Ready Region Capital Area.
2. Pass a reliability test to become a certified CLASS observer.
3. Work as a CLASS observer (contractor) in the Ready Region Capital Area, which includes the Cities of Alexandria, Fairfax and Falls Church, and Arlington and Fairfax Counties.
