Job Title: Horticultural Intern–Gardens and Plant Shop

Description:	Green Spring Gardens is a 31-acre public garden with a 1784 Historic House that offers themed
	gardens for enjoyment, education, and inspiration.

The internship will provide an introduction to common chores in a small public garden. This involves the maintenance of several garden areas, including a large Rock Garden and a conservatory. The intern will also assist the Propagation/Plant Shop team with a variety of tasks including working with volunteers and caring for the plant shop and nursery.

The internship is generously funded by the Friends of Green Spring (FROGS).

- Compensation: Interns will be temporary, part-time employees of the Fairfax County Park Authority. Compensation is \$11.20/hour for up to 300 hours. Start and end dates are negotiable.
- Requirements: Applicants must be enrolled in a two or four-year horticulture, botany, or similar plant-related degree program.
