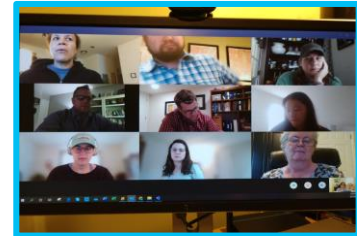

Rec-PAC is a six-week structured recreation program with emphasis on leisure skills designed for elementary school children.

Participants have an opportunity to enjoy a wide variety of activities such as: fun and fitness, indoor and outdoor games, team sports, nature, crafts, storytelling, sports festivals, talent shows and supervised play sessions. Each location has a ratio of 1 staff person to 18 participants.

JOB OPPORTUNITIES

- » **SITE DIRECTOR**
- » Oversees campers and staff
- » In charge of day-to-day operations at a Rec-PAC site.
- » **ROVER**
- » On-call to move to sites when walk-in registrations require more staff.
- » May work at different locations daily or weekly

- » **LEADER**
- » Facilitates daily activities and assists with site program planning.
- » Works with a group of campers.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- » Must be at least 18 years old
- » Staffing is based on camp registrations; there is no guarantee of weekly hours or location assignments.
- » Staff may be moved at any time to fulfill program needs.
- » A negative TB test is required by first day of training.

- » Certifications in first aid and CPR are required and must be valid through August.
- » Staff must work all six weeks of the program.

 - » Participate in camp activities with campers

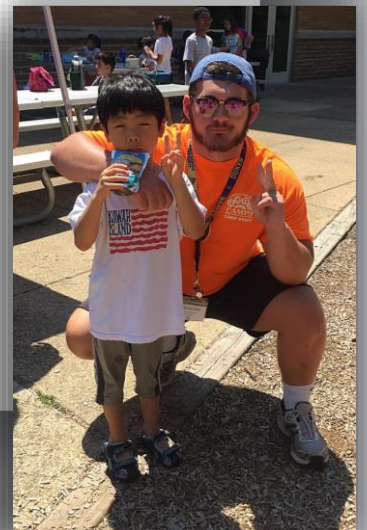
- » Camp Director

Minimum Qualifications

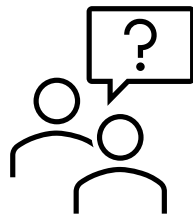
- » Camp Counselor

 - » Have or be able to obtain First Aid and CPR certification
 - » Provide a negative TB test.
 - » Agree to Criminal Background Check
- » Camp Director
 - » Must be at least 21 years old
 - » Have or be able to obtain First Aid and CPR certification
 - » Provide a negative TB test
 - » Agree to Criminal Background Check
 - » Good communication skills
