

Huntsman Lake Fishing Report

The fishing at Huntsman Lake was quite productive in early October. It was slightly windy around the lake, but the temperature reached the low 80's towards the middle of the afternoon making it a fantastic day to go out and wet a line. Jigging a Texas-rigged crawfish imitation (Googan Baits Krackin' Craw, Alabama Craw color) along the rocks on the bottom seemed to do the trick for the Largemouth Bass. Pieces of worm with a ¼ oz weight attached a foot above the hook produced an exciting catch of an albino Channel Catfish, as well as all the panfish you could handle including Bluegill, Sunfish, and Warmouth. Overall, a successful afternoon of fishing over at Huntsman Lake.
