

# COLVIN RUN MILL SCHOOL FIELD TRIPS

#### Grade Programs/Days/Times

<u>General Info</u>: Field Trips available on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 10-11:30 a.m. Additional program days and times by request.

Cost: \$8 per person for Fairfax County Public Schools and \$9 per person for all others.

### PRE-SCHOOL – 1ST GRADE MOTION IN THE MILL

Students receive a special tour of the mill geared towards younger students and visit the general store where they take part in a Then & Now activity. The program emphasizes the Science SOLs of motion and sound, Virginia history, and making connections between the past and present.

SOL: Science K.1a,f, K.2a,b,c, History/Social Studies K.1a,e,g, K.2a, K.3 & Science 1.2

#### 2ND GRADE PRODUCERS AND CONSUMERS

Students will explore three learning centers and will discover how producers and consumers interacted with the mill to create and use goods and services. They will understand the interdependence of local rural economics and the impact of resources on the development of communities in northern Virginia.

SOL: History 2.1, History/ Economics 2.8, 2.9, 2.10

#### 3RD GRADE SIMPLE MACHINES

Students tour three buildings — the mill, the barn, and the general store. Students learn about the site's rich engineering, commercial and social history. The program closely follows the Virginia Standards of Learning for Force, Motion and Energy. It provides opportunity for students to see and use simple machines.

#### **5TH GRADE** FORCE, MOTION AND ENERGY Students tour three buildings — the mill

Students tour three buildings — the mill, the barn, and the general store. Students learn about how the rudimentary properties of physics have been used to operate Colvin Run Mill for over 200 years and they will learn about the site's commercial and social history. The program closely follows the Virginia Standards of Learning for Force, Motion and Energy.
