Duties of the intern include (but not limited to):

- 1. Engage the community through marketing and outreach
- 2. Write and design flyers and posts for the farmers market newsletter and Instagram
- 3. Attend markets to assist SNAP customers and perform SNAP transactions
- 4. Help plan and facilitate events for Farmers Market Week
- 5. Attend and report on Fairfax Food Council and Urban Ag Working Group meetings
- 6. Manage data and excel spreadsheets, and perform additional tasks as assigned
- 7. Complete an independent project on themes including but not limited to food security, local food systems, community nutrition, sustainable agriculture, food sovereignty, equity

Compensation:

The intern will be a temporary, part-time employee of the Fairfax County Park Authority. Compensation is \$12.00/hour for up to 300 hours. Applicants should be able to work a flexible schedule of 15-20 hours per week.

Requirements:

- Applicants must be enrolled in a two or four-year college and be able to provide written enrollment verification. Students who graduated within the 2022-2023 academic year are still eligible.
- A qualified applicant will be passionate about local foods, community health & nutrition, and equity in food systems. Must be available August 6-12 for Farmers Market Week.
- Must be able to interact respectfully with customers, vendors, and volunteers/staff.
- Applicants must be able to provide for their own transportation, stand or sit for market duration, lift 50 pounds, work in adverse weather conditions, and perform monetary transactions.
- Applicants should have familiarity with social media platforms and ability to learn new software.
- Selected intern must provide proof of Covid-19 vaccination or get prior medical or religious exemption and may be subject to weekly testing.
