



## Experience the NEW Burke Lake Golf Center

After an 18-month construction and renovation project, the new Burke Lake Golf Center is getting rave reviews from customers. At press time, the new clubhouse with expanded dining facilities and a dedicated pro shop was just about completed and set to open by the end of October 2017.

"I love it," said golfer David Lawson of Springfield. "It's a whole lot better than what we have now with more space and a bigger pro shop."

"We're looking forward to providing expanded service to all of our customers," said manager Lewis Musolf who has worked at the course since 1997. "Our regular patrons have been following the construction progress throughout the spring and summer golf seasons and they're really impressed."

The new clubhouse is the first major construction project at Burke Lake Golf Center since it opened in 1970. It comes on the heels of a new, double-decker driving range that opened in April. Thanks to covered, heated stations, golfers will now be able to comfortably practice their shots and take lessons from Burke Lake Golf Academy during cold winter months.

"It's beautiful," said Burke Lake Golf Academy manager Meg DeMott. "For the first time, we have dedicated office space for the academy and easy access from the range to the new clubhouse."

The dedicated clubhouse dining room and outdoor patio offer golfers and non-golfers an expanded menu and a relaxed atmosphere for casual get-togethers. In addition, wi-fi access at both the range and the clubhouse make Burke Lake Golf Center an ideal place to stay connected while you're away from the office. The new facility with 21st century amenities was funded by the 2008 and 2012 park bonds and will replace the aging infrastructure to better meet the needs of Burke Lake Golf Center's growing clientele.
