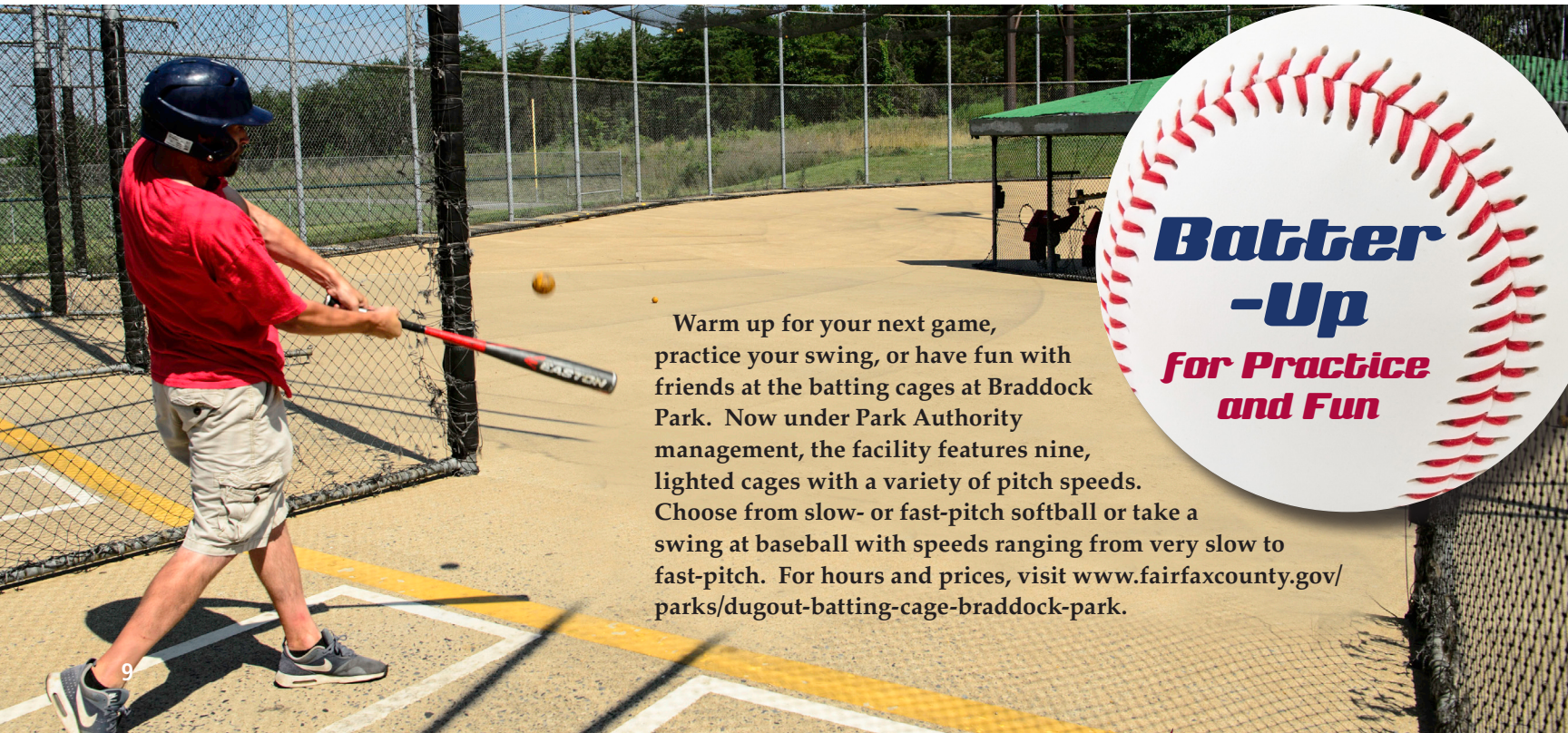


LAST CALL FOR CAMPS!
