## CURBSIDE PICKUP GETS A GREEN THUMBS UP FROM GARDENERS



With Green Spring Gardens' new curbside pickup service, there's no need to let concerns about COVID-19 exposure curb your enthusiasm for gardening. The park's Garden Gate Plant Shop offers plants and shrubs that grow well in our area, and the online order form featuring available plants is updated each Thursday. You make your selection, order and pay by phone, drive up to the curb at pickup time, and a staff member loads your order in the trunk for you. You don't even have to get out of the car!

"This is fantastic because we have really been isolating ourselves," said Debbie Porter, a retired Head Start teacher and avid gardener from Burke. "Because of risk of COVID-19 exposure, I haven't felt comfortable going into regular nurseries, and Green Spring's curbside pickup is just perfect!"

Nancy Scott, an avid gardener from Alexandria, has also been practicing social distancing during the pandemic. She says Green Spring's curbside service enables her to continue her love of gardening without fear of getting sick.

"In the absence of being able to shop myself, this is really the best option," she said. "I'm glad it's available."

The shop's plant selection includes some unusual and hard-to-find options nurtured by the park's horticultural staff. Plant sale proceeds are used by the Friends of Green Spring (FROGS) to buy plants and supplies for the shop. To see what plants are available, check out the order form online at www.fairfaxcounty.gov/parks/greenspring. Once you've made your selections, call the park at (703) 642-5173. Phone orders are taken Monday through Saturday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. and on Sundays from noon to 3:30 p.m. You'll be asked to select a pickup time when you order. Green Spring Gardens is located at 4603 Green Spring Road in Alexandria, Virginia.
