RENOVATION STATUS REPORT

Summer 2024



On Dec. 31, 2022, the Mount Vernon Rec Center closed its doors in preparation for a major renovation and expansion expected to last two years. The project will include a complete renovation of the current building, updates to the mechanical systems and expansion. When complete, the state-of-the-art facility will include two NHL-sized ice rinks, a two-level dedicated fitness area, an elevated indoor track, swimming pool, climbing wall and multi-purpose rooms. Anticipated completion is scheduled in the spring of 2025.

Project Update:

Construction progress remains on schedule for the Rec Center's renovation and expansion. Continuing changes to the building's exterior, including masonry, siding and glass will be apparent as we head into late summer and fall. Interior work is at various stages of installation progress, as is typical when sequencing the work of multiple trades.


