

Non-Recommended and Ineligible Scout Projects

This list is provided to enable scouts and their advisors to be aware of projects that the Park Authority discourages or considers ineligible. The intent of this resource is to save scouts some time as they begin to explore project ideas. Projects for which proposals are being accepted are listed in the County's online [Volunteer Management System \(VMS\)](#). Use the Groups button on the VMS dashboard to see projects available in parks. Or enter "Scout Service Project" in the key word search.

Non-Recommended Projects:

Projects on this list are generally **not** needed at park sites. Proposals for a project on this list are discouraged, unless for a specific park or program that is requesting a proposal for that project.

- Bat houses
- Kiosks/bulletin boards
- Geocaching courses
- Nesting boxes (Blue Bird, Wood duck, Insect, etc.)
- Trail boot brush stations

Ineligible Projects:

These service project ideas are **not** eligible for consideration.

- Any project not on parkland owned by FCPA (examples: school sites, BOS property, HOA common areas, state-owned land)
- Projects that introduce elements inconsistent with the park master plan
- Arbors, pergolas
- Benches (except refurbishment of existing benches)
- Bridges and boardwalks
- Dog agility equipment
- Fitness stations
- Little free libraries, pet food pantries, and similar concepts
- Memorials and memorial gardens
- Picnic tables
- Sheds
- Shelters
- Signage, including trail signage
- Stages
- Trails (except for minor trail work on an official trail)
