



2020 MARKET GUIDELINES

Thank you for keeping the markets safe by following the new social distancing guidelines at 2020 Fairfax County Farmers Markets.

Stay home if needed.




Stay home if you are sick or have been exposed to someone who is sick. If you are in a high-risk group, consider having someone else shop for you.

Limit visitors.

Please have only 1-2 shoppers per household to make social distancing easier for others. Dogs are prohibited.



Respect Market Managers.

 Managers will control market access in order to comply with capacity restrictions. Enter and exit only at designated access points. Please respect the volunteer Market Managers working to keep markets safe for everyone.

Keep your distance.

Maintain a six-foot distance from others at all times. Do not approach a booth with another customer at it.



Stop the spread of germs.

The CDC and Virginia Department of Health strongly encourage use of face coverings. Always cover sneezes and coughs. Wash hands and use hand sanitizer as needed.



Do not handle items prior to purchase.

Allow vendors to bag items and then give to you to place in your reusable bags if desired. No on-site eating or sampling.



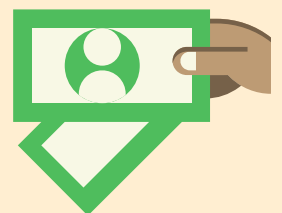
Limit visits to 30 minutes.

Leave market as quickly as possible. Review vendor information online ahead of time and pre-order where possible. Have a shopping list and exit as soon as purchases are complete. Do not stay to socialize.



Plan ahead for safe payment.

If pre-pay isn't an option, credit or debit payments preferred. Some vendors may accept hands-free payment. If using cash, be prepared with small bills to offer exact change.
