# 2019 Cardboard Boat Regatta Rules & Information (page 1) Sunday, June 2, 2019

# Please read carefully! Boats that do not comply with rules may race but will not be eligible to win.

### Rules for Building an Eligible Boat:

- Boats must be made entirely from cardboard, no more than 3 layers thick. They must not be bonded to any other material including, but not limited to, vinyl or wax (similar to what is used in packing cases).

- The boat may NOT be covered in plastic sheeting, fiberglass or other kind of resin, tape, epoxy glue or other "multi-part" glues or varnishes or other adhesive.

- Joints and seams only may be taped and/or glued. You may use glue, sealant, rubber, or contact cement, paint, or tape. Tape or sealant may not extend more than 2 inches to either side of seam.

- NO metal, wood, Styrofoam or other types of foam, or plastic may be used.
- Boats may not exceed 16 feet in length and may not exceed 10 feet in height.
- All boats must be inspected at check in. Event officials reserve the right to disqualify boats for violations of the above rules.
- Have fun and use your imagination!

### Race Rules:

- = Each boat may be entered in a maximum of two (2) race categories. A registration fee must be paid for each race category entered.
- If your boat sinks or falls apart, you are disqualified from the race and should exit the water as soon as possible.
- Boats must be controlled with paddles no motors or flippers. Paddles will be provided by the park.
- No participant may interfere with or harass another participant. Poor sportsmanship will result in disqualification.
- All participants must wear a personal flotation device (PFD) approved by the Park Authority. PFD's will be provided.

- Final Survivor race is for boats that are still sea-worthy and did not win an earlier race category. Sea-worthiness will be determined by event officials. If you are not participating in the Survivor race, please move your boat out of the way.

Race day Schedule: All boats must be dropped off and carried to the boat staging grounds (on or near the beach) by 9 a.m. This is necessary so that boats can be inspected, placed into the heat line-up, and reviewed by judges for design categories-all before the races begin. Boat inspectors will evaluate boats for size requirements and use of proper materials.

Boat inspection and judging	9 - 10:30 a.m.	During this time, stick by your boat in case the inspectors or judges have questions. And the better to show off your team spirit!	
Boat Design Awards Presented	10:45 - 11:00	Prizes will be given out to one winning boat in each design category	
Boat Races	11:00 - 2:00	Winners will be announced and prizes awarded at the end of each category race. Results will be posted at Race Information Tent.
