

Campground Host Program

Procedures for the campground host position

When	A campground host is needed each month of the year. The Lake Fairfax campgrounds are open to RV'ers year-round and tent camping April-November.
Duration	Campground hosts are asked to serve for a four (4) week period. Extended stays will be considered on a case-by-case basis. If special circumstances occur, shorter stays may also be considered.
Volunteer Selection	Hosts will be selected based on application and resume qualifications. Interviews will be conducted by the park, campground, and grounds maintenance managers.
Background Check	All volunteers must undergo a background check. This process will be done once a host has been selected. This process will be done for all returning hosts as well.
Camping Equipment	Hosts will provide their own camping unit, equipment, and personal supplies. Equipment that is needed to perform duties will be provided by staff.
Hours/Days of Work	Volunteers are asked to provide service for four (4) to five (5) days per week to include weekends and holidays. Hours and days will be mutually agreed upon times by the manager and host. Campground hosts are "on-call" to assist other campers at all times of day.
Identification	A "Campground Host" sign will be placed on the host site for camper RECOGNITION PURPOSES.
Cancellations	The Fairfax County Park Authority and/or the campground host has the option to cancel for a valid reason and reasonable notification to the other party.
Termination	Volunteers may be terminated and required to vacate the campground if performance is deemed unsatisfactory.
Host Incentives	Hosts receive a free campsite in return for services provided. From the period of Memorial Day – Labor Day, hosts will receive free admission for boating. All visits must be pre-arranged with the campground manager.
