ABOUT THE AWARD

The Sally Ormsby Environmental Stewardship Award was established by the Park Authority Board on November 14, 2007, in recognition of Sally B. Ormsby's many years of service as a citizen steward. Her actions promoted the responsible and sustainable management of natural resources. These precious assets are entrusted to the Park Authority's care by the residents of this community. Through stewardship we protect these treasures now and for generations to come. This award recognizes individuals and organizations whose actions embody the spirit and values of stewardship and result in tangible environmental benefits.

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE AWARD

The Sally Ormsby Environmental Stewardship Award is open to individuals and groups whose actions embody the spirit of environmental stewardship and provide tangible environmental benefits to Fairfax County parks.

The contribution on which the nomination is based must have occurred within the prior year (March 2018 – March 2019), but the nomination may also include accomplishments accumulated over time.

Currently serving members of the Board of Supervisors, the Fairfax County Park Authority Board, Fairfax County Park Authority staff, and the Fairfax County Park Foundation Board of Directors and their staff are excluded from eligibility.

Award recipients will be honored at a reception hosted by the Fairfax County Park Authority and the Fairfax County Park Foundation in November.
