FOUNDATION FUNDRAISING

The Fairfax County Park Foundation (FCPF) is the fundraising arm that supports the Fairfax County Park Authority (FCPA) by raising private funds, obtaining grants, and creating partnerships that supplement tax dollars to meet our community's needs for parkland, facilities, and services.

The FCPA General Fund represents less than 1% of Fairfax County's General Fund Budget. The Park Authority provides approximately 60% of its operating budget through fee-based programs and activities. Supporting programs and facilities that are not fee-based and fulfilling the growing number of requests for scholarships remains a challenge.

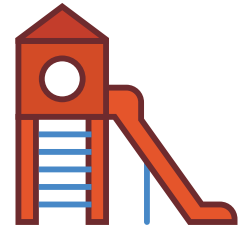
