Background

- Scheduled repaving provides opportunity to consider change in utilization
- Existing Use
 - ▶ Staff observations indicate courts 12 & 13 are underutilized
 - ▶ When in use, activities are pickleball and soccer
- Condition
 - ► Courts 12 and 13 are in disrepair
 - Few complaints in past five years, may be related to low use
- New demands
 - Pickleball advocates seek dedicated courts at Wakefield
 - ► Courts 1 through 11 are heavily used and scheduled by tennis






Court Conditions











Proposal


- Existing paddleball courts have similar dimensions to pickleball

 - ► Costs and timing of ADA improvement
