Burke Lake Park Camping Rules and Regulations

The following rules apply to conduct within campgrounds owned and operated by Fairfax County Park Authority and Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority. Violation of any of these rules may subject the violator to ejection from any park.

- 1. Alcoholic beverages of any kind are prohibited.
- 2. All campers must register with the park personnel, showing valid identification and paying the appropriate fee prior to occupying the site.
- 3. Organized group camping in designated areas only.
- 4. Only registered campers and their guests may use the camping facilities.
- 5. A single camping stay may not exceed fourteen (14) consecutive days. All campers must vacate a campsite for a minimum of seven (7) days between single camping stays.
- 6. Campsites are limited to one (1) camping trailer and one (1) non-camping vehicle. Tent campers may have (2) non-camping vehicles per site.
- 7. All campers must have a camping trailer, travel trailer, tent, or other camping vehicle. Camping or sleeping in the cab or bed of a truck, in an automobile, or on the ground without a tent is prohibited.
- 8. Campsites are limited to seven (7) campers per site, per night.
- 9. Service and/or commercial vehicles, tractors and construction equipment are not permitted in the campground.
- 10. Campers are to check out at 12pm on the date of their departure.
- 11. Campers 17 and under must be supervised by an adult 18 years and older.
- 12. Visitors to the campground must vacate the park by quiet hour. (10:00p.m.)
- 13. Campers must observe quiet hours between 10:00p.m. and 7:00a.m.
- 14. Pets left unattended in the campground will be reported to the Animal Warden. Pets must be kept on a leash at all times.
- 15. Campgrounds are restricted to use by campers only for the sole purpose of recreational, non-residential, overnight accommodations.
- 16. Dumping sewage or dishwater onto the ground is prohibited.
- 17. Campers must keep campsite clean at all times. Do not put glass, cans, bottle tops, etc. in fire rings. Please put all trash in dumpsters that are provided. If you need a small bag for trash, ask at the camp store.
- 18. All motorized vehicles and trailers must be parked in designated parking areas.
- 19. Refunds are given for one night only.

FOR EMERGENCIES ONLY. FIRE REGULATIONS

- 1. Grounds fires are permitted in the fire rings only.
- 2. Grills for charcoal use only. Wood fires are prohibited in grills.
- 3. Cutting of trees and collecting of downed trees or tree limbs is prohibited.
- 4. Do not leave fires unattended.
- 5. Fires must be extinguished before retiring for the night or departing the campsite.
- 6. Exercise extreme caution at all times.
