

The Visioning Guiding Principles were drafted as a final product to be shared with and solicit further feedback from the community."

Values:

People forging common ground and envisioning a future that can meet a variety of community needs.

Full Spectrum of Stakeholder Voices:

Ensuring a balanced understanding of community values, interests and concerns.

<u>Dialogue:</u>

People seeking to understand each other.

Real Input:

Input that can be used to help shape decisions.

Process:

Provide information that places all participants at a shared level of understanding, and community input that is integrated with decision-making.

Purposes

- Set community goals for land use and development
- Maintain the quality of life for County residents
- Promote the public health, safety and welfare
- Manage growth and impacts of development
- Preserve environmental and cultural resources





In Use

- Establish the standards for using County codes and ordinances
- Identify and set policies for establishing appropriate land uses throughout the County
- Target community and county-wide needs for public facilities and services





- Provide laws or regulations
- Determine when development will occur or how it will look
- Address all issues a community may face

Lorton South-Route 1 Community Planning Sector

- Create a focal point of development or "Town Center" and stronger "sense of place" (identity)
- Develop a strong "sense of place" and positive image for the area
- Provide an effective and efficient transportation network
- Promote safe pedestrian access to retail and mixed-use areas
- Promote adequate buffering and screening and appropriate transitional land uses between residential areas and nonresidential uses
- Encourage additional open space, parklands, and recreation areas
- Protect natural and historic resources
- Acquire environmentally sensitive areas through the Environmental Quality Corridor program



Why amend the Comprehensive Plan?

Considerations for updating the Plan for Lorton:

- Significant changes since the current Plan was adopted.
- Identify development patterns, services, amenities, public facilities and other attributes that may be beneficial for the community.
- Examine sites that could provide greater benefits community with updated land use recommendations.
- Focus on assets throughout the community that can be better supported or linked to strengthen the identity and character of Lorton.
- Provide greater access to the sites, amenities, services, and facilities that make Lorton such a unique place to call home.



2019 Lorton Community Survey Results

Employment

- **22%** Work in Lorton **33%** In Lorton
- **60%** Work elsewhere

Events / Entertainment

- **29%** In Lorton
- 66% Elsewhere

Retail Shopping

- 89% Elsewhere

Dining Out

- **73%** In Lorton
- 86% Elsewhere

<u>Public Facilities (more needed)</u>

- 81% Traffic Improvements
- **76%** Pedestrian Improvements
- **74%** Park Improvements
- **56%** Sports Facilities
- 53% Public Transit Access and Options

















Does Lorton need a commercial center/heart?








2019: Lorton needs a heart






