
Q14 What are the important assets and amenities (existing or future) outside of the Focus Area that should be considered as key components that can contribute to the identity of Lorton? Select all that apply.



## Connections to Area and Regional Attractions




### **Lorton Visioning** – Connections to Natural Resources and Recreation
