### LAND USE ACTIONS

During the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of Fiscal Year 2022, the Planning Commission acted on **25** applications; affording 23 citizens an opportunity to speak at the 10 public hearings held. The district with the highest number of applications considered was the Hunter Mill District with 7 applications acted upon.

#### **Land Use Process Review Committee**

Met on May 12<sup>th</sup> with the Department of Planning and Development staff for presentations on a pending Zoning Ordinance Amendment on signage, and a follow-on motion from zMOD regarding landscape contractors and professionals offices. Staff's presentation topics included background, current regulations and processes, proposed changes, timeline, and community outreach plan. Staff responded to the Committee's questions and provided feedback received from the community.

Met on May 19<sup>th</sup> with the Department of Planning and Development staff for presentations on the Site-Specific Plan Amendment retrospective and the Zoning Ordinance Work Program.
