

LAND USE ACTIONS

During the 2nd quarter of Fiscal Year 2024, the Planning Commission acted on **40** applications; affording 34 citizens an opportunity to speak at the 8 public hearings held. The district with the highest number of applications considered was the Providence District with 8 applications acted upon.
