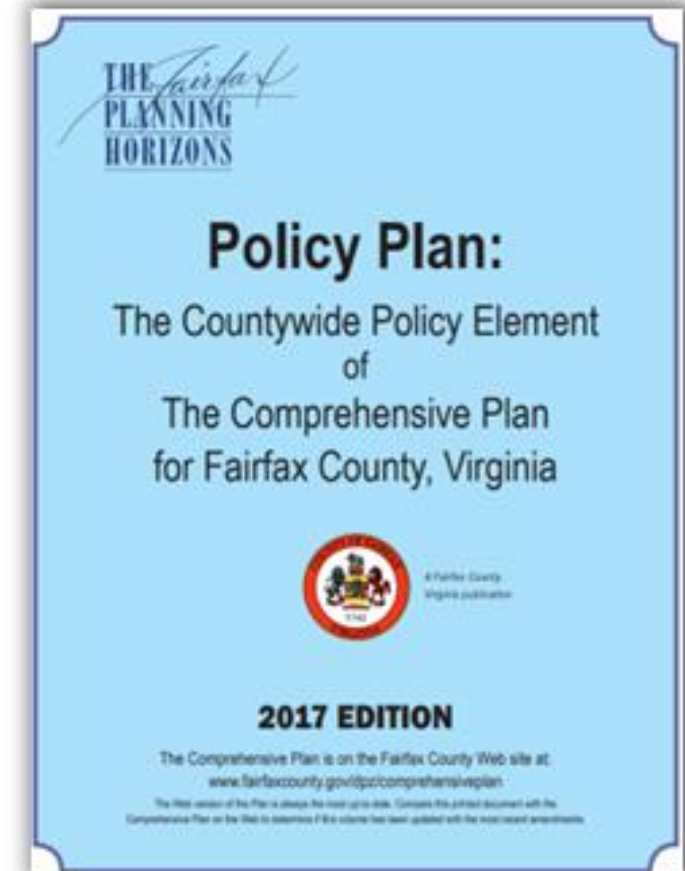

<b>Multimodal Integration</b>	Focus on integrating motorized and non-motorized transportation to reduce single-occupancy vehicle (SOV) use and improve air quality.			
<b>Public Transit Expansion</b>	Support the extension of Metrorail and development of public transit options like HOV lanes and park-and-ride lots in key corridors.			
<b>Pedestrian and Bicycle Infrastructure</b>	Develop a comprehensive network of sidewalks, trails, and bike routes with safe, accessible features.			
<b>Transportation Demand Management (TDM)</b>	Promote alternatives to SOV travel, such as public transit, ridesharing, biking, and teleworking.			
<b>Context-Sensitive Roadway Design</b>	Ensure roadways provide adequate access and capacity while being sensitive to environmental and community impacts.			
<b>Cost-Effective Improvements</b>	Prioritize transportation projects that align with land use, environmental goals, and future demands.
