- Strategies implemented by the City of Philadelphia that allowed the public and private sector to assist with a variety of tasks;
- The year-round maintenance requirement for natural landscaping;
- The different landscaping needs for rural areas versus urban areas;
- Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) points and rating systems;
- Minor edits to Objective 6, Policy a;
- Minor edits to the Natural Landscaping paragraph.
