


2020 Traffic Warning Data: January 1 - June 30





- The total represents the unique number of times a warning was issued; not the unique number of individuals issued a warning ticket. During this data collection period, FCPD did not record unique identifying information of the individuals issued warnings. Due to the method this data was collected and extracted; it is not possible to discern if one individual was issued multiple warnings during this timeframe.
- The data coding is standardized by the Virginia State Police and the Federal Bureau of Investigation's NCIC code manuals and Hispanic is not included in these codes as they
 classify Hispanic as an ethnic indicator, not a race. Effective July 1, 2020, the Virginia State Police will expand their data coding to include Hispanic.
- Data reported reflects all citations issued and regardless of the individual's actual domicile as a county resident or not.

*NOTE: The data presented in this report was extracted from FCPD internal records management systems by the Information Technology Bureau (ITB). It includes only calls for service events reported as traffic stops that follow the department guidelines for documenting the stop as a warning. Data is representative, but not exhaustive.
