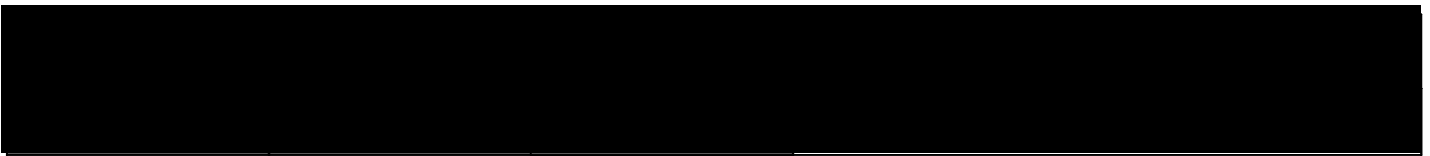

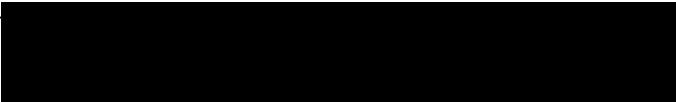

Notes/Narratives

On 1-20-15, I was notified by School Security that there were two female students in the clinic who were drunk. I responded up to the Clinic and Rescue was just arriving onscene. The two students were identified as [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] was taken to the Principal's conference room located in the front office. [REDACTED] eyes were blood shot and when she was talking she was all over the place with her thoughts. The principal, [REDACTED], witnessed [REDACTED] stumble down the hallway.

[REDACTED] admitted to drinking some of the tequilla that was in a plastic water bottle. The alcohol was brought to school by [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] stated that on her way to her 4th period class she saw a female student [REDACTED] holding up [REDACTED].
