On 1-20-15, I was notified by School Security that there were two female students in the clinic who were drunk. I responded up to the Clinic and Rescue was just arriving onscene. The two students were identified as [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] eyes were blood shot and her speech was slurred. [REDACTED] admitted to drinking alcohol in school. [REDACTED] put Tequilla in a plastic water bottle and brought it to school.

[REDACTED] drank the alcohol in her 2nd period class (there was a substitute teacher in the class). [REDACTED] stated that she felt [REDACTED] but didn't want to tell her teacher. When she was getting dressed after class she felt [REDACTED] [REDACTED] felt like she was going to throw up so her friend [REDACTED] took her to the bathroom. The girls saw [REDACTED] in the hallway and [REDACTED] asked them what was going on. [REDACTED] stated, 'she is drunk.' [REDACTED] while they walked her to the bathroom. [REDACTED] began to vomit and then she fainted. There were three 7th graders that happened to walk into the bathroom and saw [REDACTED] The 7th graders were scared and went immediately to the clinic [REDACTED] and Mr. [REDACTED] went to the bathroom and they saw [REDACTED] pop her head out of the bathroom and said, 'We don't need help anymore.' [REDACTED] continued into the bathroom.

The front office tried several times to reach [REDACTED] mom but they were not successful. [REDACTED] went in the ambulance with [REDACTED] Rescue was took [REDACTED] due to the fact that she vomited several times and fainted. Eventually we were able to contact [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]
