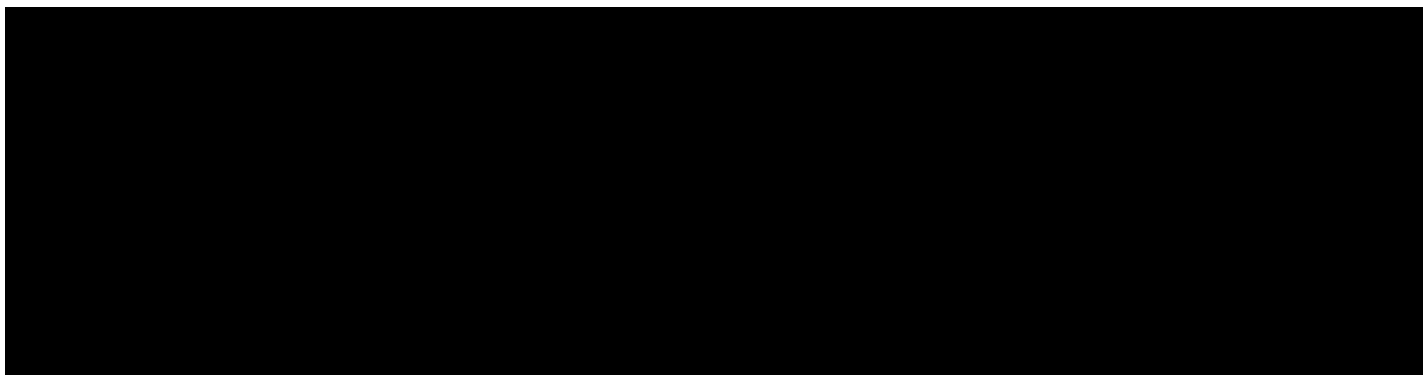

Notes/Narratives

On March 4th, 2015 a teacher at Sandburg [REDACTED] reported that she received five inappropriate/harassing emails from a student. There were four emails sent to [REDACTED] school email address on 2/28/15 from this email address: [REDACTED]. A fifth email was sent on March 3rd from a different email address [REDACTED]. The email belongs to an 8th grade student, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was never a student in [REDACTED] class. The contents in the emails were sexual in nature. No pictures were sent.

[REDACTED] came to the school and met with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] gave his ipod to [REDACTED] to look through his emails. [REDACTED] found several emails in the trash can that were sent to the victims. [REDACTED] admitted to [REDACTED] that he sent those emails. After seeing these emails, [REDACTED] called me to the front office.

After the school completed their investigation I reported to the front office and spoke to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] admitted to sending those emails but could not provide an answer why. He made very little eye contact with me and spoke softly. I then spoke to [REDACTED] and she stated they also have a home computer. [REDACTED] father was deported in October 2014. [REDACTED] lives with his [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. The siblings both attend school and the cousin does not attend school or have a job. [REDACTED] has no school discipline history. [REDACTED] does not know the password to his ipod. The school social worker, [REDACTED] met with [REDACTED] and his mom and suggested that [REDACTED].

The school suspended [REDACTED] for 10 days and his case is going to the Hearings Office. [REDACTED] wants to press charges. I will seek a petition for computer harassment. There are three other victims. See related case numbers: 20150580102, 20150630113, and 20150710052.
