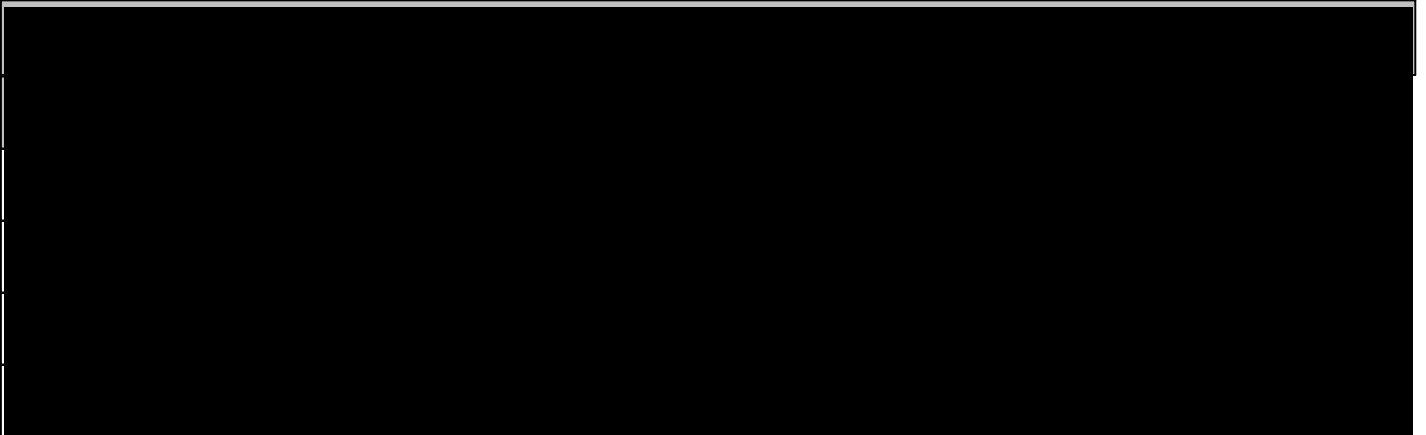

Notes/Narratives

On 3-24-15, [REDACTED] was standing in the hallway prior to 1st period beginning. She was standing outside her classroom, [REDACTED] monitoring the halls. The teachers stand outside their classrooms to help remind students to keep moving and to get to class on time. [REDACTED] stated that there is a constant problem upstairs with boys congregating in the hall and blocking the hallways for other students to pass by. [REDACTED] asked the boys that were not using their lockers to move on and get to class. Most of the students left, but one refused to leave. This student later identified as, [REDACTED] went to several lockers pretending it was his locker. [REDACTED] kept insisting that each one was his locker. After three attempts of trying to get [REDACTED] to move on, [REDACTED] asked for this student's name and he replied, 'that's none of your business, bitch.' At this point she asked this student to walk with her to go and speak with an administrator. [REDACTED] pushed past her using his elbow, striking [REDACTED] in her midsection, in an attempt to leave. She then grabbed his jacket so he would stop. [REDACTED] then began yelling at her, 'I'm going to stab this ho.....I'm going to glass this ho.....and get the fuck off of me.' [REDACTED] then grabbed [REDACTED] right wrist and shoved her into the lockers on the opposite side of the hallway [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] back was pressed against the lockers and [REDACTED] was still holding her wrist and he was jabbing his elbow into her ribs. At this time another teacher, [REDACTED] came down the hallway and asked [REDACTED] to let go of [REDACTED] wrist. [REDACTED] continued to use profanity and finally after about 45 seconds of [REDACTED] asking him to let go, he finally let go and took off down the stairs. [REDACTED] followed [REDACTED] to class and he asked the [REDACTED] to call for security and/or the SRO. [REDACTED] walked by his [REDACTED] and stated, 'I don't care about no fucking cop.'

[REDACTED] is an 8th grader and has no reason to be upstairs. His locker is downstairs and his first period class was P.E. [REDACTED] was taken to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] called his mom ([REDACTED]) to notify her of the assault and that she needed to pick up her son from school immediately.

I met with [REDACTED] in the principal's conference room. [REDACTED] stated that he went upstairs with two of his friends, who were going upstairs to their lockers. [REDACTED] said he went with them to ask them for a pencil. While upstairs he said a teacher told him to go to class and he replied, 'I'm at my friend's locker.' [REDACTED] walked away down the hallway but turned around and went back to his friends. He said that this teacher just grabbed his collar and started chocking him. He asked her to let go and she did not so he said, 'I guess we are going to be like this for the rest of the day.' [REDACTED] said he started to walk to class with her holding him by the collar. He walked towards her and she backed up into the locker. He said that [REDACTED] followed him to class but once he [REDACTED] he decided that he wanted to go talk to [REDACTED] during the morning announcements.

I have several teachers that witnessed this assault and [REDACTED] aggressive behavior upstairs. [REDACTED] wants to press charges and I informed [REDACTED] of this. I also explained the process to both of them. I have sent the Intake form and the report to South County Juvenile Intake.
