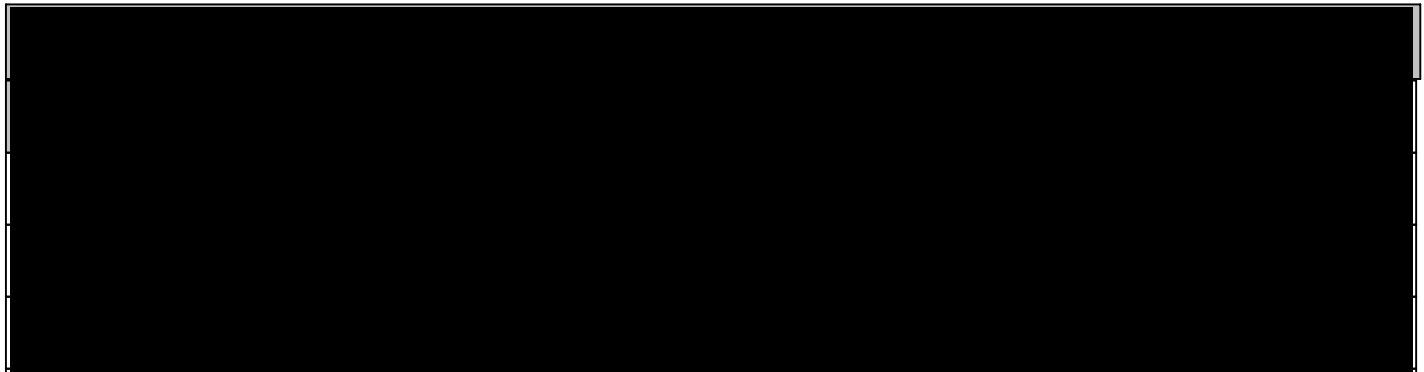

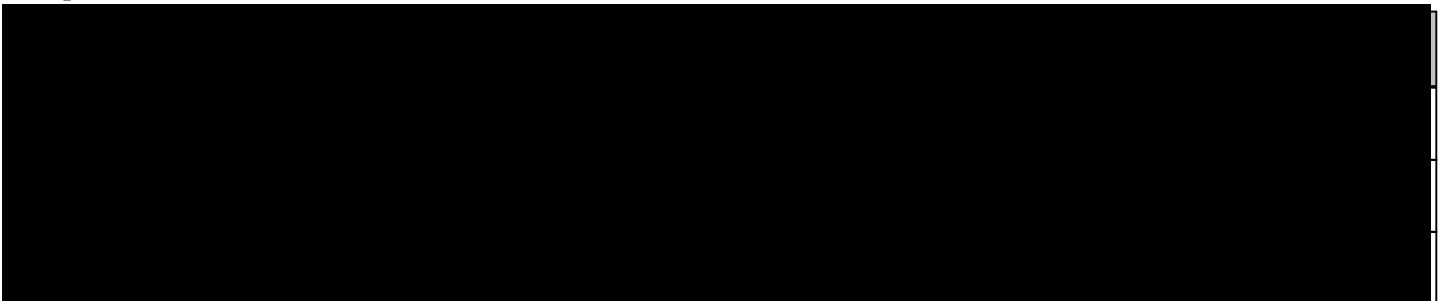

### Notes/Narratives

On 5-8-15 an 8th grade student, [REDACTED], came to my office to report that another student stole his iphone. [REDACTED] at Sandburg MS) came with [REDACTED] to my office. [REDACTED] stated that this took place on 5-7-15 during his 3rd period class. [REDACTED] let another student, [REDACTED] borrow his phone during the class. According to [REDACTED] he couldn't find [REDACTED] at the end of the period to give it back to him so another student, [REDACTED], said he would see [REDACTED] and would return it to him. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] brought [REDACTED] to my office on 5-8-15 around 1440 hours. [REDACTED] stated that he gave it to [REDACTED] that same day after he borrowed during class. [REDACTED] first stated that he gave it back to [REDACTED] and has no idea what happened. Then [REDACTED] stated that he took the phone home with him and said he will give it back to [REDACTED] over the weekend because he knows where he lives. I attempted to call [REDACTED] guardian but got no response and was not able to leave a message.

On 5-11-15, I followed up with [REDACTED] and his mom and they advised that the cell phone was not returned. I spoke to [REDACTED] and now his story is that his [REDACTED] saw the iphone at home and took it. [REDACTED] said he told his [REDACTED]. I called [REDACTED] and attempted to explain to her what was going on and to ask her if she knows where this phone is. She began yelling at me, interrupted me multiple times, and ultimately hung on me at 1005hours. I made several attempts to let [REDACTED] know that he will be charged with grand larceny.
