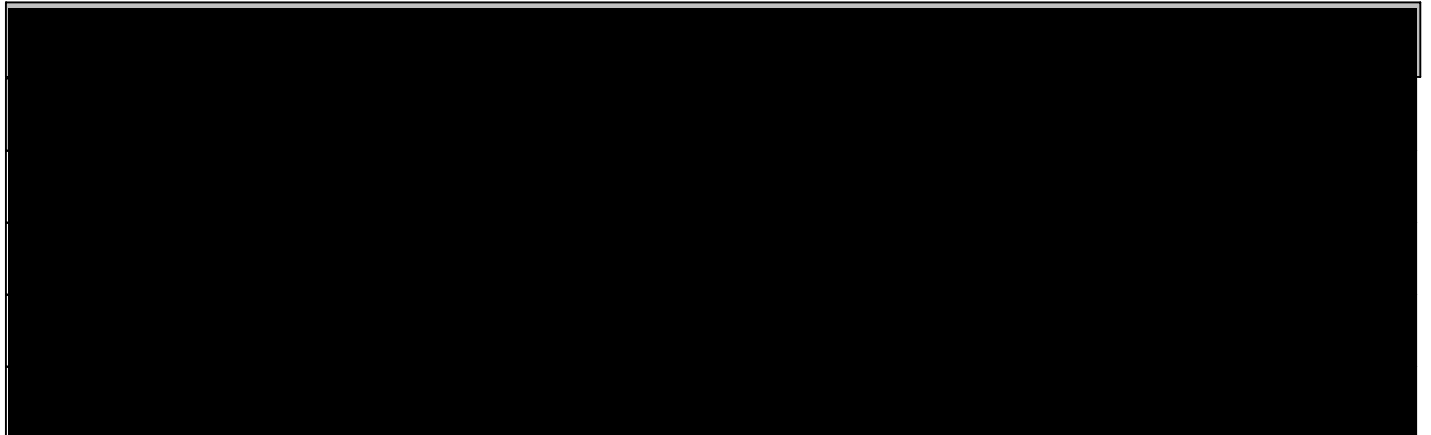

## Notes/Narratives

On 5-18-15, a teacher ([REDACTED]) was in the hallway between class exchange to help remind students to get to class. A student who was identified as [REDACTED] and some other students were congregating near room 422/424. [REDACTED] asked the students to keep moving and at that point [REDACTED] turned towards [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] noticed [REDACTED] wearing a sweatshirt that appeared to be a violation of FCPS dress code. The phrase on his shirt was `We Trippy Mane`. [REDACTED] attempted to talk to [REDACTED] about the sweatshirt but he became very agitated and refused to answer his questions about the meaning on his shirt. [REDACTED] gave him a few options rather than having to call for School Security or for the 8th grade [REDACTED] refused to talk to [REDACTED] and walked off towards the [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] had another teacher call for security and he continued to follow [REDACTED] wanted to make sure [REDACTED] didn't leave the building. School Security met up with them but [REDACTED] walked right past security. [REDACTED] kept talking about leaving school. [REDACTED] ordered [REDACTED] to sit down in a chair and calm down, however [REDACTED] refused and pushed past [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was also present and called for the SRO. Once I arrived, I observed [REDACTED] on the ground and [REDACTED] were holding him down. I attempted to talk to [REDACTED] but he became more agitated and said, `Go ahead and arrest me.` [REDACTED] kept trying to hide something in his waistline, it did not appear to be a weapon, but he would not tell us what the object was. I noticed a few students in the hallway and immediately told them to go a different way. For the safety of [REDACTED] and others, I handcuffed him.

I escorted [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] and the school staff called [REDACTED] mom to inform her of the situation and she immediately came to the school. While I was escorting [REDACTED] to the office he said, `You guys better watch your back.` [REDACTED] searched [REDACTED] and he had a lighter, a condom, and a hookah pen in his possession. [REDACTED] was talking about his brother and made the statement, `I don't care about him or what he has to say, I will stab him.` I also notified [REDACTED] was at the courthouse and walked over to Intake. Intake suggested that we take him to [REDACTED] was also in agreement. I had a patrol officer [REDACTED] [REDACTED] because my cruiser does not have a cage. Myself and [REDACTED] followed them up to [REDACTED] spoke with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] said he did not see any reason to send [REDACTED] to the [REDACTED] therefore I turned [REDACTED] back over to his mom's custody. I notified [REDACTED] that I would be obtaining a petition for Disorderly Conduct.

I sent the report and Intake form over to South County Intake for a Disorderly Conduct petition.
