Notes/Narratives

On 6-4-15 around 1410 hours, a student came to my office to report that someone just stole [REDACTED] iPhone from the Boy's locker room. The student, [REDACTED] class and they were changing out because the period was about to end. [REDACTED] stated that he accidentally left his phone on the locker room bench under his jacket. He realized this within a few minutes and went immediately back into the locker room, but all of his personal items were gone. He asked the [REDACTED] if anyone turned in his personal items. The answer was no, therefore, [REDACTED] came to my office to make the report. I had [REDACTED] call his mom to let her know what was going on and to see if she could track the phone for him. The phone had been turned off.

[REDACTED] mentioned two possible witnesses, [REDACTED] went to [REDACTED] classroom and brought [REDACTED] back to my office. [REDACTED] was in my office on an unrelated issue so he searched [REDACTED] and all of his belongings. There was no phone in his possession, however, he finally stated that as he was leaving [REDACTED] he noticed that [REDACTED] left his jacket and phone case behind. [REDACTED] claimed that he was going to give it back and that all he saw was the phone case. However, when [REDACTED] went to pick him up in class he left those two items behind, despite being told to bring everything. [REDACTED] was able to recover the jacket and the phone case. [REDACTED], (either the number wasn't working or unable to leave a message) claims he had no idea where the phone was and that when he picked up the case and jacket, the case was empty.

Since it was the end of the day I wasn't able to talk to anymore students. On 6-5-15, I spoke to the other witness, [REDACTED] notified via email). [REDACTED] stated at the end of [REDACTED] left his phone and jacket on the bench in the locker room. [REDACTED] watched [REDACTED] walk over to the bench and pick up the phone and jacket. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] asked him if he should take the phone and [REDACTED] responded, 'You do what you want.' [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] to take the jacket but [REDACTED] told him no. After school [REDACTED] that he threw it away in the outside dumpster and he didn't know if it was still in there.

[REDACTED] was hearing from other students that [REDACTED] handed the phone to another [REDACTED] because he was 'getting too much heat.' [REDACTED] have the same [REDACTED] and are friends. I spoke to [REDACTED] on 6-8-15 (parents were notified) and he tried to deny his involvement at first. He finally stated that while in [REDACTED] asked him to hold this phone. [REDACTED] later went to School Security to pick up his headphones that were taken earlier in the day. Security had left for the day and I happened to have the headphones sitting on my desk. I gave the headphones back to [REDACTED] At the time not knowing that [REDACTED] were in the same class. [REDACTED] leaves my office and about two minutes [REDACTED] leaves because the dismissal bell had rung. [REDACTED] 'Why' and [REDACTED] replied, 'It is mine.' So [REDACTED] trashed it. The phone was not recovered.

I spoke to another student who knew what was going on stated that he asked [REDACTED] in the lunch on 6-5-15 if he stole [REDACTED] phone and he said, 'Dude don't tell or say anything.' This student then told [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] mom wants to press charges. The phone was entered into TTY by operator #309997. TTY# is 1515600021. [REDACTED] was suspended from school for 5 days. I sent the report and Intake from over to JDC for petitions.
