On June 18, 2015 I responded to the Mount Vernon Station for a Lost Property Report. Upon my arrival I made contact with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised that she attends Carl Sandburg MS. [REDACTED] stated that on June 17, 2015 she went to an assembly in the auditorium of the school between 0900-1000hrs. [REDACTED] stated that she believes she had the phone then, but about halfway through lunch (about 1045). [REDACTED] stated that she asked Janitors at school if they possibly had located her phone. [REDACTED] also went back to the auditorium and was met with negative results.

[REDACTED] is not sure if the phone was stolen or if she misplaced it. [REDACTED] stated that there were some people sitting behind her during the assembly. She stated these people were arguing and felt that this was suspicious. I advised [REDACTED] a report would be written and she would be notified if the phone was located. I suggested that the phone be disabled.

I provided [REDACTED] and her mother a business card with a case number. The missing phone is an Iphone 5C. The phone has been entered into the property module.

Supplement Notes

On 6/19/15, [REDACTED], the mother of [REDACTED], came into the station and told the PCA that she wanted to speak with someone about this report. I agreed to meet with her and she told me that her and her husband had found their daughter's cell phone for sale on Craigslist. She provided me with a printout of the actual ad that was posted about 14 hours earlier. The ad was selling a blue iphone 5c for \$100 and contained pictures of the phone in the post. The ad also stated that the phone did not come with any cables or a charger. [REDACTED] believed it was definitely her daughter's phone because two of the pictures showed a few small dents in the top right corner of the phone that her recognized. The ad gave the name [REDACTED] to contact to purchase.

[REDACTED] provided me with the serial number and IMEI number for her daughter's phone. She told me that she wanted me to contact the seller and then go purchase the phone immediately. At one point she told me she was going to wait in the lobby of the station while I worked on the case and purchased the phone. I told her that I would do my best to contact the seller and call her as soon as I had some information on the phone. She eventually left the station very disappointed. I returned to my office and inspected the Craigslist ad further and was able to blow up the photo of the phone that showed the IMEI number displayed on it. I could not make out every digit on the phone, but the few that I could see clearly did not match the numbers on her daughter's phone. I then called [REDACTED] and spoke with her husband and explained to him what I had found out about the phone for sale online. I explained to him that he could also blow up the picture to confirm what I had seen and call me if he had any further questions or concerns. I never heard back from him or his wife. No further action was taken.
