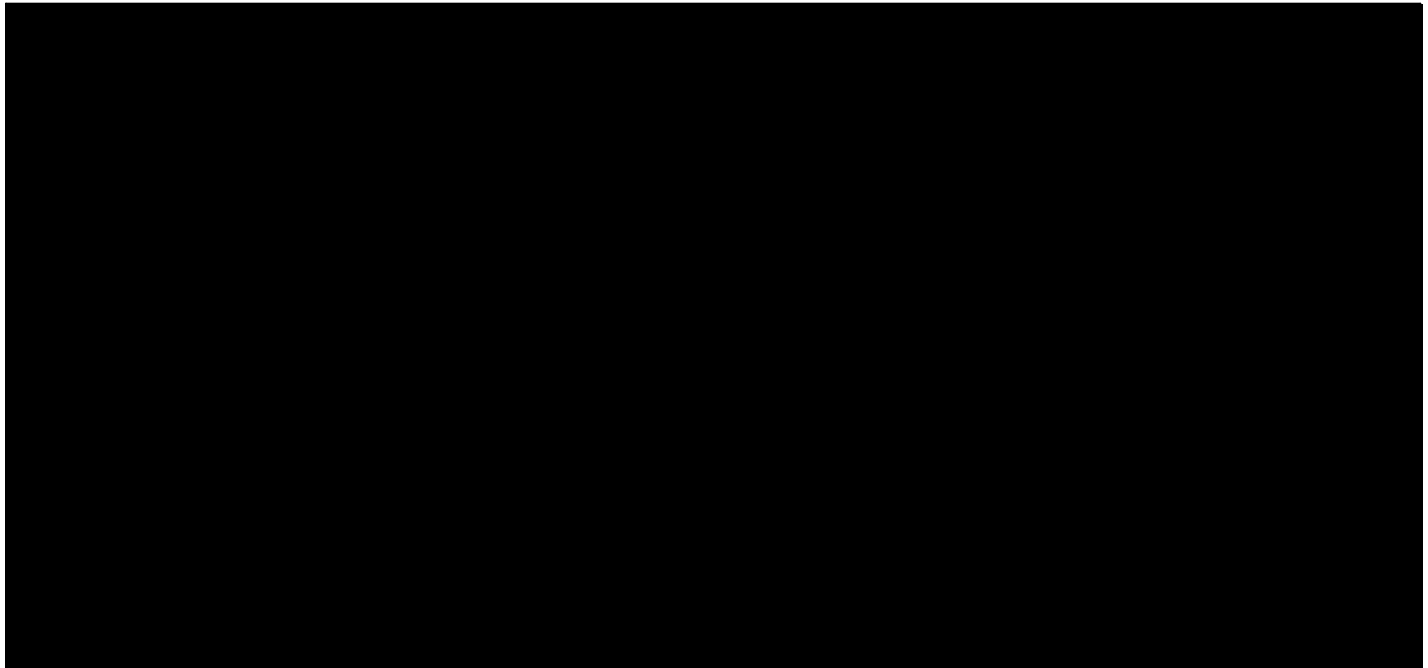

## Notes/Narratives

On 9-18-15 around 1130 hours, [REDACTED] was turning onto school grounds from Ft. Hunt Road and observed a female student getting out of a vehicle on Ft. Hunt Road. [REDACTED] recognized the female as [REDACTED] who is currently an 8th grader at Sandburg. [REDACTED] did not recognize the unknown male who dropped her off on the road instead of taking her to the front office. The red vehicle had a Maryland license plate, unknown tag. [REDACTED] reported this to [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] later in the afternoon and [REDACTED] told her a story that did not make any sense. [REDACTED] stated that her friend, [REDACTED] paid this male to drive her to school since she missed the bus. [REDACTED] is a 9th grader at West Potomac HS. [REDACTED] did not know anything about this unknown male.

[REDACTED] was involved in an [REDACTED] case back in April [REDACTED] where there was an arrest made. Since that event [REDACTED] mom took her cell phone away.

[REDACTED] came to school to meet with myself, [REDACTED] (Parent Liason, translator) on 9-21-15 at 1330 hours. [REDACTED] was not present. [REDACTED] stays in her bedroom from the moment she gets home from school and does not engage with the family. She is not helpful at home. [REDACTED] is always trying to use her littler brother's tablet/ipod to connect to the house WiFi. [REDACTED] has found different phones, ipods, etc in [REDACTED] possession on several differnt occassions. According to mom, the school assigned her a latop and mom has caught her up late at night on the laptop. Yet, still has not taken the laptop from [REDACTED] does not want to be apart of the family and according to mom it is becuase she resents the family. [REDACTED] has 4 children. [REDACTED] is the 3rd child and was the only one born in El Salvador. All the other children were born in the United States. [REDACTED] came to the United States when she was about 8 years old. According to mom, she was smuggled into the United States and almost died. Mom also mentioned that [REDACTED] was prescribed sleeping pills but never takes them. [REDACTED] has a hard time falling asleep and mom has noticed from time to time that the mouthwash is missing.

On 9-18-15, [REDACTED] takes her to the bus stop in the mornings. [REDACTED] mentioned that [REDACTED] might know the app that [REDACTED] uses secretly. Mom could not remember. [REDACTED]

According to another student [REDACTED] who happens to be [REDACTED] cousin, stated that on 9-18-15 he saw [REDACTED] on the bus that morning. [REDACTED] never went to her 1st period class. The automated phone system should have alerted mom that [REDACTED] was not in class however we discovered that the number was wrong in the system which is why mom never knew she was absent. It just hapened to be a concidence that [REDACTED] get out of that vehicle.

I spoke to [REDACTED] about this event. I have not questioned any parties involved in this case. I have sent this case to [REDACTED] for follow-up given [REDACTED] history.
