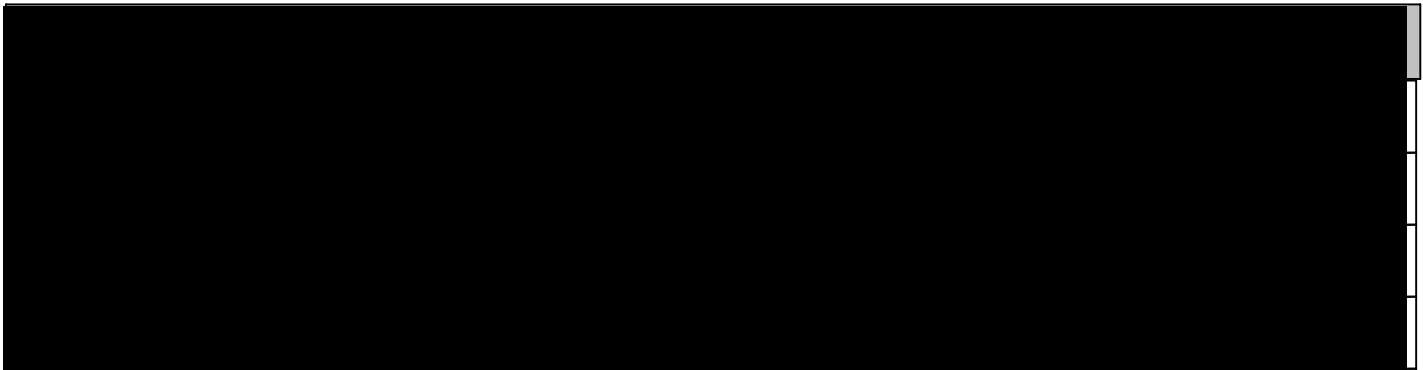

### Notes/Narratives

On 10-6-15, I was walking through the cafeteria during B lunch (1046-1116 hours) and stopped to talk with a teacher [REDACTED] suddenly pointed over in the direction of the vending machines and stated, "That's a fight over there!" I ran over in that direction and began yelling at the large group of kids to back up and for the two students to stop fighting. I then observed two female students [REDACTED] [REDACTED] actively fighting. The girls would not stop fighting so I stepped inbetween them to separate them. They continued to try and pull each others hair while I was separating them. One administrator, [REDACTED] came over and took [REDACTED] out of the cafeteria and I took [REDACTED] to her counselor's office.

Both parents were notified of the incident in the cafeteria. [REDACTED] does not want to press charges. Each student was given 5 days of OSS.
